Notes:

1. If you are a full-time student, all courses within a designated Block are to be taken during the same semester. If you are enrolled part-time, please see the Communication Disorders (CD) Program Director to discuss the correct sequence of courses. Note: CD478, CD479, and CD490 are no longer offered or required in the Block sequence.
2. If you are unable to take, or successfully complete a Block at any point in the sequence, it will delay completing of the undergraduate CD curriculum by a minimum of one (1) year. Please consult a CD program faculty member to identify appropriate alternative courses.
3. At minimum, a student should meet with an academic advisor one time per semester to plan coursework in the major, minor coursework, and electives. A student should meet with CD program faculty as needed.
4. The following courses **are all required** for CD majors, but may be taken at any time during the undergraduate program prior to the completion of Block 6: **CEP110G, SPED350, CD374, CD375, and CEP451G.**
